Premises: The surgery is a listed building with 9 consulting rooms, 3 treatment rooms and 2 waiting rooms over 2 floors. There is disabled access and consulting rooms on the ground floor for patients unable to use the stairs. There is no onsite parking. There are 5 Partners, three Salaried GP and 1 Registrar, with 4 Practice Nurses, 2 HCAs and a phlebotomist. The Practice covers Dartmouth and the surrounding villages of Dittisham, Blackawton, Strete and Slapton. The surgery is open from 8.30 am to 6pm Monday to Friday. The Practice offers all general medical services but in addition has the in house expertise of an ENT GPwSI, plus GPs with Cardiology experience.

Aims and Objectives:

- To provide good Primary Medical Services to our local community. To include the management of patients who are ill, or believe themselves to be ill, with conditions from which recovery is generally expected, for the duration of that condition, including relevant health promotion advice and referral as appropriate, reflecting patient choice wherever practicable. To understand, and meet the needs, of our patients, involving them in decisions about their treatment and care.
- To provide the general management of End of Life patients.
- To provide the management of chronic disease in the manner determined by the Practice, in discussion with the patient.
- To provide LESs, or their equivalent, which may be commissioned from the Practice by a CCG. Local Authority or NHS Commissioning Board.
- To be committed to our patients needs and to act with honesty, integrity and complete confidentiality.
- To be courteous, approachable, friendly and accommodating.
- To provide our patients with an environment which is safe and effective but also comfortable, relaxing and friendly.

- To improve as a patient centered service through decision making and communication.
- To ensure that all members of the team have the right skills and training to carry out their duties competently.
- Maintain high quality of care through continuous learning and training.
- To guide our employees in accordance with diversity and equality.
- To ensure robust and effective information governance systems are in place.
- To treat all patients and staff with dignity, respect and honesty.
